
Come and join us for an inspiring and informative Farm Walk conducted by Burke Brandon on this beautiful, certified organic lamb and beef farm.

The farm applies regenerative grazing practices amongst landscape revegetation. 20% of the farm has been revegetated, with 30,000 trees being planted over the last 25 years along the Foster Creek and steep slopes.



About Burke and Bronwyn: Burke and Bronwyn Brandon breed prime lambs and beef on their 195 acre certified organic farm in Moyarra. Half the farm is creek flats, which are primarily used for high density sheep grazing, and the Speckle Park cows and calves grazed in the hills.

They took over the property from Korumburra Landcare Group members Lyn & Bruce Herbert in 2011, who had completed significant revegetation along the Foster Creek and steep hill escarpment.



The Walk

The walk is of moderate level along a good track. It involves a steady climb with a couple of short, steeper stretches. 1.3km to top of the hill, 80m elevation. Optional additional 500m walk to Moloki Creek. (This adds a further 1.0 km round trip to the walk)

What to Bring / Wear

- **BYO Light Lunch**. Tea & Coffee provided on arrival and at lunchtime.

- Dress appropriately for the weather conditions.
- Wear sturdy shoes/boots, bring walking poles to assist with the steeper sections of the walk if required.

Parking Take the farm driveway on right hand side of the entry to the property. Parking around the sheds
